Principal's updates:

- The two key things that students should do: Attend all classes; try their best/ask for help
- Administrators and Counsellors are available to work with students to resolve issues they might have,
 parents have access to consultations as well, the career information advisor mainly support grade 11/12
- RHS learner profile combined with IB learner profile being resilient, responsible
- Diversity at school students are asked to interact with everyone with kindness, care, and respect
- Punctuality matters over 100 students arrive at the school late (after 8:30 am). Let's make sure our kids start their day on time
