We aim to provide a safe and engaging outlet for RHS Students to have fun, be creative, and explore STEM. We hope that this club will enable participants to explore these hobbies in an engaging and inclusive environment, as these hobbies may seem intimidating or difficult to approach alone. We will be incorporating aspects of science and engineering in our events, such as experimentation and problem-solving, as we will be primarily using our own designs instead of kits. Model rocketry, which involves launching of model rockets made of lightweight materials and a motor, is very safe as long as safety guidelines are followed, much like many other everyday activities. We will provide the necessary construction materials and rocket motors from Estes, one of the most well known and respected vendors in the hobby. We also have a good supply of RC plane parts. Our activities will primarily revolve around the construction of low-power model rockets and RC planes. We plan to start off the year by constructing simple designs, before moving on to incorporate more advanced features and having design/construction competitions. Explanations of physics and aerodynamics will be included within these activities for those curious.
