


Post-Secondary Institutions Explained

- UNIVERSITY Undergraduate (bachelor's) degrees, Graduate (master's or doctoral), Diploma programs
- COLLEGE Some Bachelor's degrees/
 Associate degrees/Univ. transfer, Diploma/certificate programs –
 Career specific, trades, Academic upgrading programs.
- TECHNICAL INSTITUTION —
 Degree/Diplomas/Certificates Technical/Trades program

NOTE: B.C - post-secondary education system integrated= Established transfer

OPTIONS

- Over **1,900** programs (Canada)
- 11 universities (98 in Canada)
 - UBC, UVIC, SFU, Emily Carr, Kwantlen, Capilano University etc.
- 11 colleges (69 in Canada)
 - Langara, Douglas, etc.
- **3** Technical Institutes
 - BCIT, Vancouver Community College, JIBC (Law Enforcement)



Careers in Trades

- What is a trade job? A highly specialized job!!
- Big demand easier to find a job
- Red Seal Endorsement (RSE) Highly Recognized!! Work anywhere –Canada/USA
- Tuition is less expensive (compared to University programs)
- Earn while you learn (apprenticeship) 4 years
- High wages, attractive benefits
- Excellent career advancement

- BCIT Electrician, Aircraft Engineer, Plumbing, Carpentry, Boilermaking, Welder, Machinist...many more trade specialties.
- Camosun College (Victoria, BC) Electrician, Plumbing, Culinary Arts, Automotive, Heavy Mechanics...







WHAT **GRADES**ARE REQUIRED TO BE OFFERED ADMISSION?

Grades requirements for admissions will vary for each Institutions? Depends on program....

- Contact ADMISSIONS (email/Phone)
- Attend Information Sessions (Online/Inperson)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Every University will have their **unique** "Admission Requirements" *Visit their website!!!*

- 1) Visit HOME page
- 2) Check General Admission Requirement High school Graduation & English 12 (min. %) Min.% requirement may vary from each institution!!
- 3) English proficiency Standardize testing (T.O.E.F.L (80-90), E.I.L.S.T 6.0-6.5.)
- 5). Select "UNDERGRADUATE, DIPLOMA, CERTIFICATE" CHOOSE PROGRAM -Check admission requirements!!
- ***Do you have program specific subjects for program?? These will be assessed for admissions Grade 11 evaluated first......then <u>Grade 12 courses when available!!</u>
- 6) Requirements have been met!! Submit your application !!!
- 7) Submit Documents when required Check emails!!

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

- 1) Visit COLLEGE HOME website Go to "admissions requirements"
- 2) General Admission Requirements High school Graduation, English 12 (min. requirement will vary)
- 3) Do you meet "*Program requirements*"? Have Grade 11/12 courses?

Apply Early! First Come First Serve = Early course registration!

Check your email for further instructions – Documents/high school transcripts...

TRADES – ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- BCIT/VCC/Camosun College.. and other Technical Institutions— <u>Visit</u> website
- Choose Trade program –Admission Requirements? Entrance requirements are program-specific i.e., *Principles of Math 11 or 12 or Pre-Calc.11 or 12, Physics 11 or 12, English 12, Mechanical aptitude test*
- Seats are quite limited/competitive Apply early!
- Contact admission/website for availability
- Information Sessions Website

Post Secondary Application

- If you're studying in **B.C.**...
- Create an account e.g. **Educationalplannerbc.ca**name, email, password
- After creating your personal account...select Post Secondary Institutions (Be sure to have a few)
- Begin your application to your selected PSI Choose program of interest, Term/start date
- Pay application fee Credit card


Student Transcript Service

- Visit Student Transcript Service (STS) BCeID.ca
- Register for a Basic BCeID account Allows you to view/order your high school transcripts (Gr.10-12)
- Transcripts will be automatically sent (electronically) to your Post Secondary schools of your choice. FREE (25 transcripts) \$10 each
- To register/create account, choose: Current student
- Personal Education Number (PEN)
- A valid email address
- Your date of birth
- Your legal first and last name
- Be sure to "activate" your BCeID account (within 24 hours)

Note: Be sure to choose to have your transcripts sent automatically with updated (interim/final)grades for one year.

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Apply to multiple schools
 - keep options open <u>2nd</u> <u>Choice of Study</u>
 - consider a college transfer
 - many programs are very competitive
- If you're applying to a US PSI, be sure to check if SAT/ACT is required.
- Make an appointment write SAT/ACT

- University/College Entrance Check website! Entrance awards for early application - Application deadline will vary!
- Other scholarships Separate applications Financial Aid

Loran Scholarship – Application (online)deadline – **Oct.10**

- School Nominated See RSS Website under "Student Information" - "Nominated scholarship" application. i.e., Schulich Leader, National,
- RHS Scholarship Visit RHS Website under "Students" "Grade 12 Information" - Scholarship application link is now open
- Applications are comprehensive, often requiring reference letters, nominations, essays and transcripts

- Prepare now –Do your research- Each post-secondary program has different admission requirements.
- Apply.. when you're ready (Create a list of PSIs....pros & cons/compare!!)
- Have more than one option of study (back-up) Compare programs/Institutions
- Know/record important deadlines Vary for each PSIs
- Check for updates regularly emails
- Attend information sessions
- Seek out advice/ask questions I'm here to help (email, appointment, drop-in)
