

Q	Focus	Targeted, skill-specific training designed for immediate task readiness.	Comprehensive, accelerated career -focused education combining theoretical knowledge and practical skills.	In-depth academic study emphasizing theoretical knowledge and research within a specific discipline.
\odot	Duration	Short (a few weeks to complete)	Medium	Long (4 years or more depending on degree type)
(S)	Cost	Lower investment. Fewer resources mean fewer fees, resulting in lower cost.	Moderate investment. Intensive job-focused programs that usually include hands-on training and can be completed in about a year.	Higher investment. High cost from rising tuition, extended study time, and student expenses.
